Bundelkhand University is a State Government University located in Jhansi, Uttar Pradesh, established in 1975 to expand access to higher education across the Bundelkhand region. It offers programmes across disciplines including management, commerce, science, engineering, pharmacy, law, agriculture, education, humanities and other professional fields. It is recognised by the UGC and is included by NIRF in the State Public University category. Bundelkhand University has also established a Centre for Distance and Online Education (CDOE) to extend flexible higher education beyond the physical campus. The CDOE currently offers eight ODL programmes and positions the university's distance-learning initiative around accessible, affordable and flexible education.
