Module 1: Introduction to GDA & Patient Care (5 subjects)

- ◆ Understand the role and responsibilities of a General Duty Assistant
- ◆ Ensure patient comfort and basic care
- ◆ Assist nurses and doctors in patient-care activities
- ◆ Maintain a clean and safe hospital environment
- ◆ Support patient-care planning as instructed



Curriculum Overview (continued)

Module 2: Personal Hygiene, Grooming & Dressing (11 subjects)

- ◆ Assist patients with bed baths and bathing
- ◆ Support oral
- ◆ hair
- ◆ nail
- ◆ foot
- ◆ eye
- ◆ nose and ear care
- ◆ Assist with skin
- ◆ back and perineal care
- ◆ Help patients with dressing
- ◆ Support prevention and management of bed sores

Module 3: Nutrition & Elimination Support (4 subjects)

- ◆ Assist patients with eating and drinking
- ◆ Support assisted and tubal feeding
- ◆ Understand basic patient nutrition
- ◆ Assist patients with toileting

Module 4: Patient Mobility & Positioning (5 subjects)

- ◆ Transfer patients from bed to wheelchair
 - ◆ Transfer patients from bed to stretcher
 - ◆ Assist patients while walking
 - ◆ Support safe patient positioning
 - ◆ Maintain patient safety and comfort during movement
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Module 5: Nursing Assistance & Bed Care (4 subjects)

- ◆ Assist nurses with routine procedures as per the care plan
 - ◆ Support occupied bed making
 - ◆ Support unoccupied bed making
 - ◆ Maintain cleanliness and comfort of the patient area
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Module 6: Patient Monitoring & Reporting (8 subjects)

- ◆ Observe and report changes in patient condition
- ◆ Measure and record blood pressure
- ◆ Measure temperature and pulse oximetry
- ◆ Monitor respiration
- ◆ Measure height and weight
- ◆ Monitor blood glucose
- ◆ Assist with ECG monitoring
- ◆ Record patient parameters accurately



Curriculum Overview (continued)

Module 7: Hospital Support & Death Care (6 subjects)

- ◆ Transport patient samples
- ◆ medicines and documents
- ◆ Manage and transport hospital laundry
- ◆ Maintain confidentiality and safe handling practices
- ◆ Assist with last office and death care
- ◆ Follow hospital procedures while handling the deceased

Module 8: Biomedical Waste & Infection Control (6 subjects)

- ◆ Segregate and dispose of biomedical waste safely
- ◆ Follow healthcare waste-management protocols
- ◆ Adhere to standard precautions
- ◆ Follow infection-control practices
- ◆ Maintain hand hygiene and personal protection
- ◆ Prevent cross-contamination and maintain a hygienic healthcare environment
